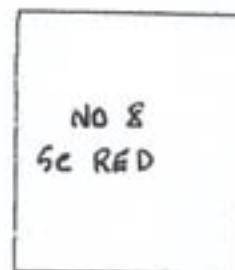

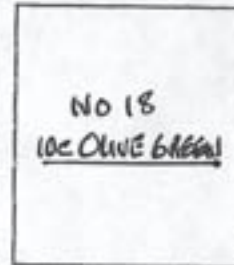
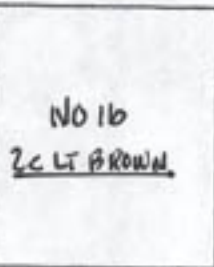

# Great Britain

## NATIONAL TELEPHONE STAMPS

1884 Engraved on white to tinted wove. no wtmk. perf 12



Introduced in 1884 because of the need to keep a strict accounting inasmuch as the Post Office got 10%. Subscribers to the Telephone did not have to pay for calls but non-subscribers did. Therefore, tally sheets were used in the call office on which subscribers simply signed their names while non-subscribers attached stamps to the value of the call. The stamps were discontinued in 1891.
