The **Honorable Sir Charles John Pearson** was a judge of the Supreme Court of Scotland. Born in Midlothian, England on November 6, 1843, he was the second son of Charles Pearson C.A. Edinburgh.

He attended the Edinburgh Academy, Edinburgh & St. Andrews Universities and the Corpus Christi College in Oxford.

His career consisted of the following positions:

Advocate Scotch Bar – 1870

Sheriff of Chancery – 1885-88

Procurator for the Church of Scotland – 1886-90

Sheriff of Renfrew and Bute – 1888

Sheriff of Perthshire – 1889

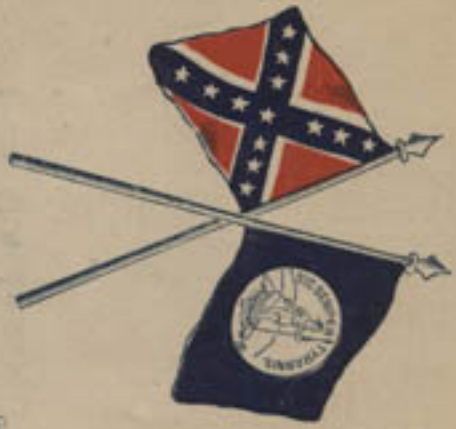
Solicitor-General for Scotland 1890

M.P. (C.) Edinburgh and Andrews Universities – 1890-96
