

YUGOSLAVIA – JUGOSLAVIJA

Yugoslavia, known prior to 1929 as The Kingdom of the Serbs, Croats and Slovenes, emerged in 1918 when the Kingdoms of Serbia and Montenegro united with Bosnia and Herzegovina, Croatia, Slovenia and other Austro-Hungarian provinces. Several of these countries issued their own stamps during World War II when Yugoslavia was dismembered. Yugoslavia became a Federal People's Republic in 1946 and gained control of a part of the Free Territory of Trieste. Area: 98,766 square miles; Population: 17,853,000 (1956); Language: Serbo-Croat, Slovene and Macedonian (all official); Capital: Belgrade. 100 Heller = 1 Krone (Bosnia-Herzegovina). 100 Filir = 1 Kruna (Croatia-Slovenia). 100 Vinar = 1 Krona (Slovenia). 1920: 100 Para = 1 Dinar.

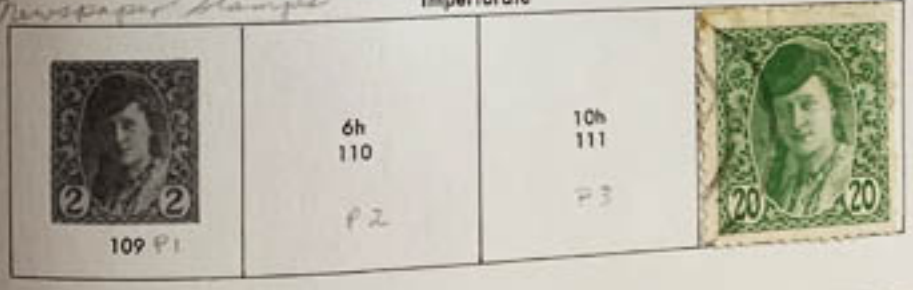
