THE MOST POWERFUL WEAPON OF WAR EVER DEvised BY MAN - THE ATOMIC BOMB - WAS FIRST USED ON THE CITY OF HIROSHIMA, JAPAN - DROPPED BY A B-29 OF THE U.S.A.A.F.
