

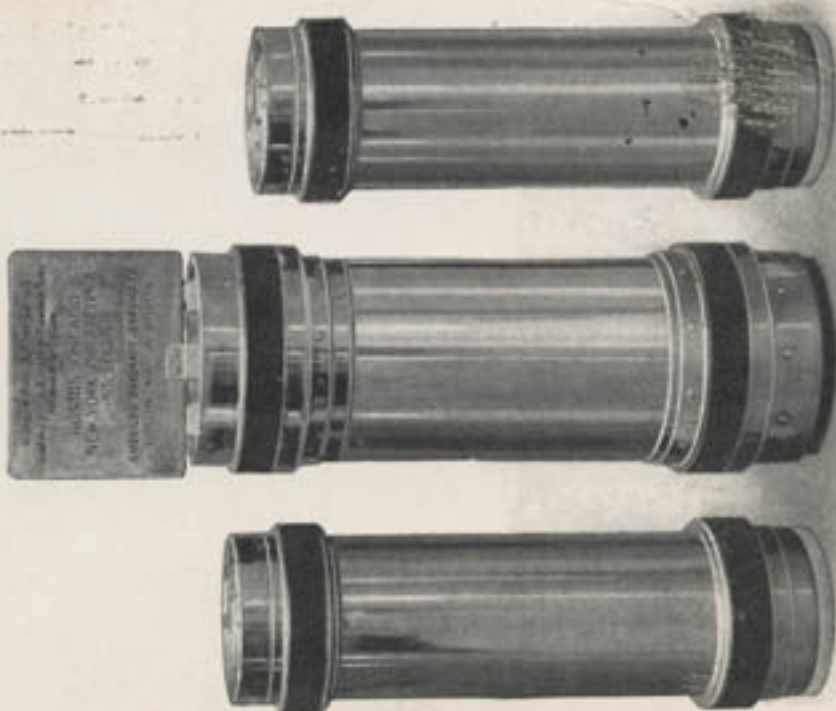


LINCOLN BEACHY

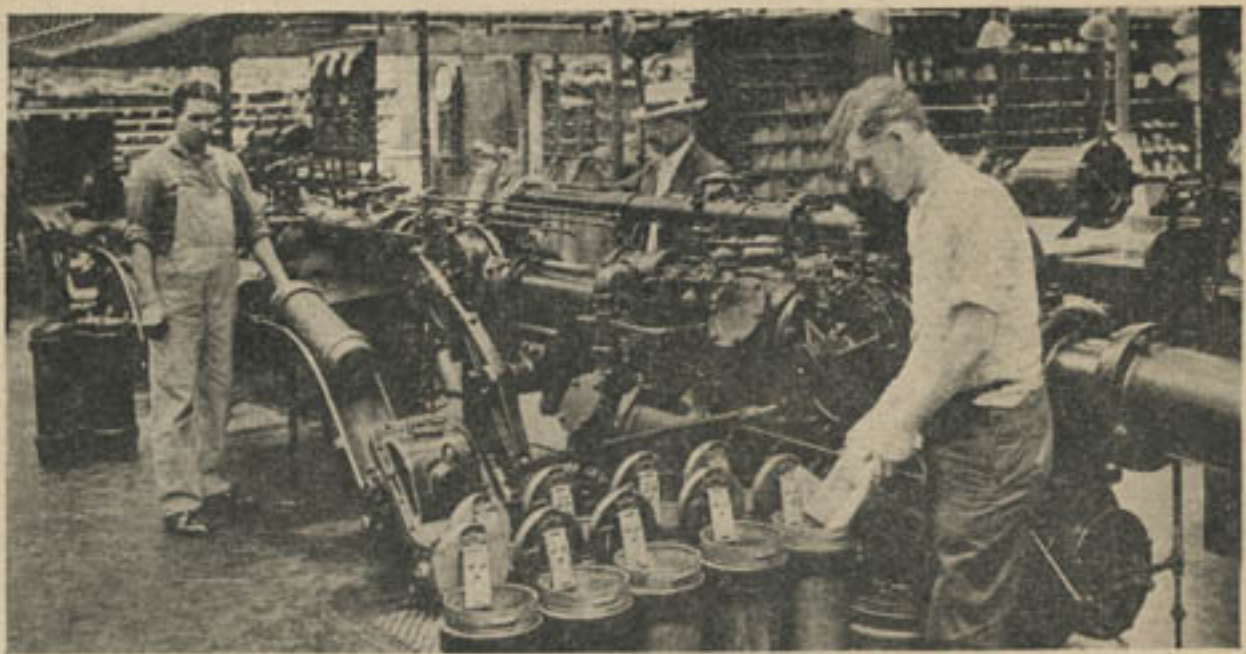


Above Picture Taken 5 Years ago.

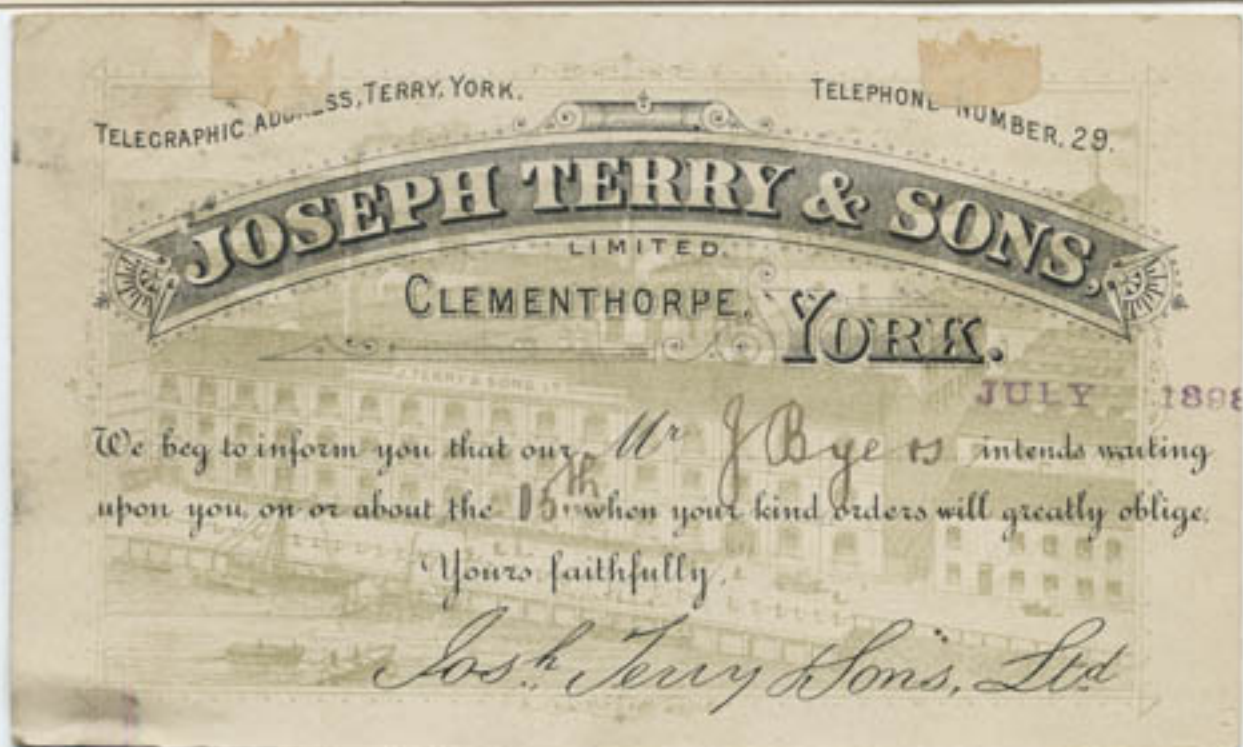

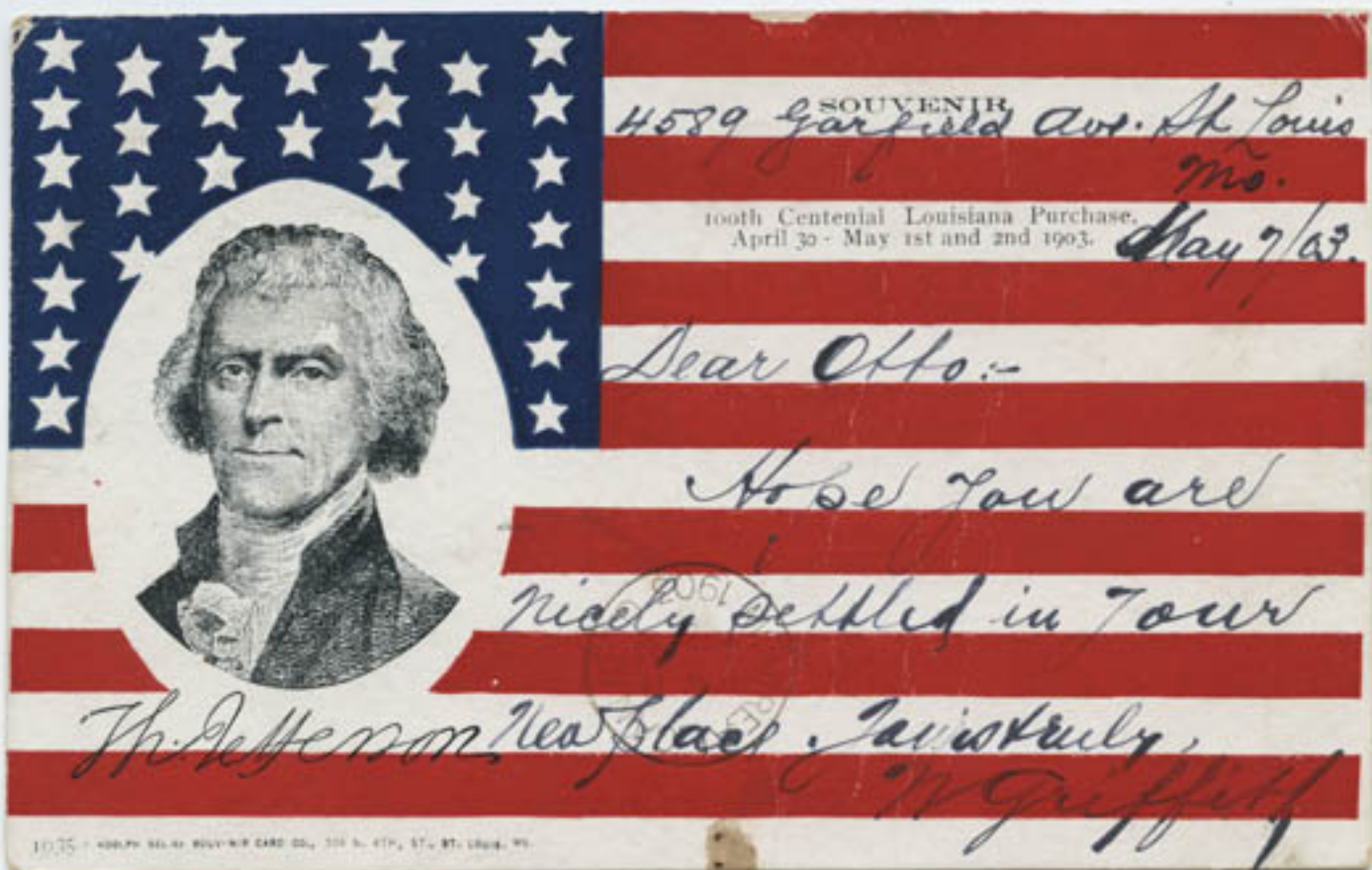
