1959

The creation of an embankment to reclaim Kojima Bay, Okayama Prefecture for farmland, was the subject for this stamp marking the completion of work. It was placed on sale February 1, 1959.

## HUMAN RIGHTS

1958



*Flame: Symbol of Human Rights*

This stamp was placed on sale December 10, 1958 to commemorate the tenth anniversary of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights.

The 15th meeting of the International Air Transport Association was held at the Imperial Hotel, Tokyo, beginning October 12, 1959. This stamp, featuring a crane and the IATA emblem, commemorates the meeting.
