Government is a sacred trust of the people, the authority for which is derived from the people, the powers of which are exercised by the representatives of the people, and the benefits of which are enjoyed by the people.

We, the Japanese people, desire peace for all time and are deeply conscious of the high ideals controlling human relationship, and we have determined to preserve our security and existence, trusting in the justice and faith of the peace-loving peoples of the world.

Hanging Lantern

The 1974 New Year's Greeting stamp pictures a hexagonal cast copper hanging lantern with designs of plum trees and bamboos on the doors and panels. The lantern was unearthed from the grounds of the Chiba-dera Temple in Chiba City, near Tokyo, and bears an inscription dated 1550.

The opening of the Kan-Mon Bridge is commemorated by this issue. The bridge, which connects Honshu with Kyushu, is 1068 meters long and took five years to construct. The stamp was designed by Saburo Watanabe.



Old Man and Rice Mortar

An old Japanese fable, "The Old Man Who Made Trees Blossom," is the basis for these stamps which are the first of a planned series featuring popular Japanese folktales. Kenkichi Sugimoto painted the original pictures, and Saburo Watanabe adapted these for the stamp designs. The date of issue was November 20, 1973.
