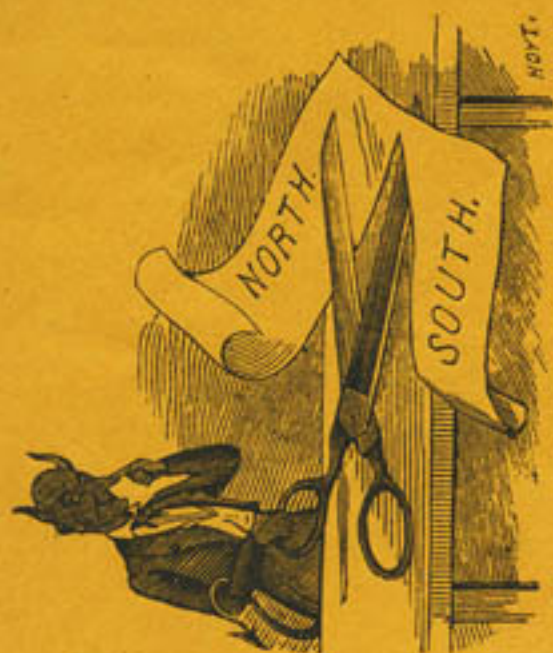

Knoxville, April 22, 1861
