Discovered in 1535 by French explorers, the St. Lawrence River has been used as a gateway to the middle of the North American continent. In 1954, work began to make this mighty river into a deep-sea channel highway, capable of carrying ocean-going vessels. On June 29, 1959, Queen Elizabeth II and President Dwight D. Eisenhower dedicated the completed St. Lawrence Seaway, 2300 miles of locks and canals, connecting the mouth of the St. Lawrence and the western tip of Lake Superior.

Stamps of similar design were issued by Canada and the United States in commemoration of the event. Several copies of the Canadian issue were discovered with inverted centers.

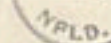
