ON SALE THREE DAYS, DECEMBER 6TH, 7TH & 8TH. USED ON MAIL CARRIED ON SPECIAL FLIGHT FROM BELGIUM TO LEOPOLDVILLE, CONGO, BY PILOTS VAN LINDER AND THERY. THE PLANE LEAVING ON THE 7TH, 15,000 COPIES WERE SOLD THE FIRST DAY. THE STAMPS WERE DEMONETIZED.

THE 15Ø ISSUED MAY 1926, WHEN SERVICE WAS EXTENDED TO MALMO SWEDEN. SYMBOLIC DESIGN BY AXEL JENSEN, SURFACE PRINTED BY THIELE AND COMPANY, COPENHAGEN.

AIRPLANE OVER PYRAMIDS.

SURCHARGED IN BLUE OR VIOLET

To commemorate the visit and flight over Egypt of the "Graf Zeppelin". Only ten sets were sold at the post office to any one person. The issue was distributed as follows:-- 1,600 sent to Postal Union Office at Berne; 2,950 sets destroyed as poorly printed; 2,000 sets kept by the Government; 8,000 sets used on mail; 1,000 sets used to order at the only four offices where stamps were on sale - (Cairo, Alexandria, Port Said and Suez). Thus leaving approximately 9,450 sets for distribution. Many minor varieties in the Arabic Printing may be found. Surcharge made in Cairo, at the Government Printing Works.

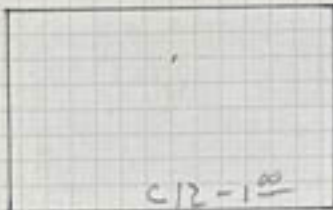

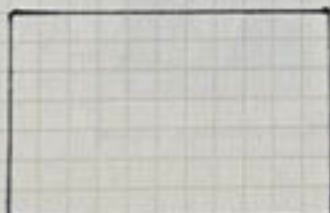


BIPLANE IN FLIGHT.
