Provided, always and it is hereby agreed and declared
between and by the said parties hereto that the assign-
ment hereby made is by way of mortgage only to
secure unto the said Paul Osenberg his executors,
administrators of the said sum of Two thousand
dollars on the 12th day of Sept. 1878 with
interest thereon in the meantime and until payment
of the said principal sum at the rate of 8% per cent
per annum by equal payments, semi-annually on
the 12th days of March and Sept^r in
each year clear of all deductions. On which payments
being well and truly made these presents shall become
void. But if default shall be made in payment of
the said principal sum or the interest thereon or
of any part thereof on the days whereon the same
shall become due as aforesaid. Then it shall be lawful
for the said Paul Osenberg his executors, adminis-
trators or assigns to seize and take possession of the said
steamer with her appurtenances, and to sell the same and
also the said share on the said Brig by public auc-
tion after giving four weeks notice of such sale and to
receive the purchase money therefor and execute all
such documents as may be necessary to transfer the said

vessel or share to the purchaser thereof. - And out of the proceeds of such sale to pay and satisfy the expenses thereof, and to retain pay and satisfy the said principal sum and interest up to the date of the receipt of such purchase money. And the balance if any shall be paid to the said F. S. Pratt his executors, administrators or assigns.
