2 **1840's-50's, group of stampless covers**, an interesting group of 20 covers (some with contents) with neat paid 3, 5, 10 and free frank cancels along with an early document paying tax in Sandwich, Massachusetts, Fine. Estimate \$150 - 200



3 **1850's, 4 folded letters with PAID handstamps and Boston c.d.s.**, all imaged on the website, Fine to Very Fine. Estimate \$50 - 75

7  **1848, incoming folded letter to Baltimore from Rio de Janeiro, Brazil**, by private ship (“per Sarah via New York”), with red New York SHIP 7 cts postmark (5¢ inland postage + 2¢ ship fee), Fine to Very Fine, Ex-Brouillette. Estimate \$50 - 75




10  **1860, incoming folded letter to New York from Chile**, via British packet; postmarks include Valparaiso, Chile; PAID TO PANAMA; and STEAMSHIP 10; file folds, otherwise Very Fine, a scarce usage, Ex-Brouillette. Estimate \$150 - 200




8  **1900, picture post card from New York to British East Africa**, nice Black Americana usage to a scarce destination, Fine to Very Fine. Scott 279B. Estimate \$75 - 100




11  **1880, cover from New York to Chile**, with 3-color franking folded over the top edge to act as a seal. Note the Panama transit cancel on front (no backstamps), nearly Fine, a scarce destination in this period. Estimate \$60 - 80

Late 1850's to ca. 1910, collection of cartes de visite, a dozen different small photographs on cards which proved to be a very popular item during the American Civil War, soldiers, friends and family members would have a means of inexpensively obtaining photographs and sending them to loved ones in small envelopes; additionally, photos of Abraham Lincoln, Ulysses S. Grant, and other celebrities of the era became an instant hit in the North, people were not only buying photographs of themselves, but also collecting photographs of celebrities. Estimate \$25 - 35

These small photographs were patented in Paris by photographer André Adolphe Eugène Disdéri in 1854, although first used by Louis Dodero. They were usually made of an albumen print, which was a thin paper photograph mounted on a thicker paper card. The size of a carte de visite is 54.0 mm (2.125 in) 89 mm (3.5 in) mounted on a card sized 64 mm (2.5 in) 100 mm (4 in). In 1854, Disdéri had also patented a method of taking eight separate negatives on a single plate, which reduced production costs. The carte de visite was slow to gain widespread use until 1859, when Disdéri published Emperor Napoleon III's photos in this format. This made the format an overnight success. The new invention was so popular it was known as "cardomania" and it spread throughout Europe and then quickly to America and the rest of the world.

Each photograph was the size of a visiting card, and such photograph cards were traded among friends and visitors. Albums for the collection and display of cards became a common fixture in Victorian parlors. The immense popularity of these card photographs led to the publication and collection of photographs of prominent persons.

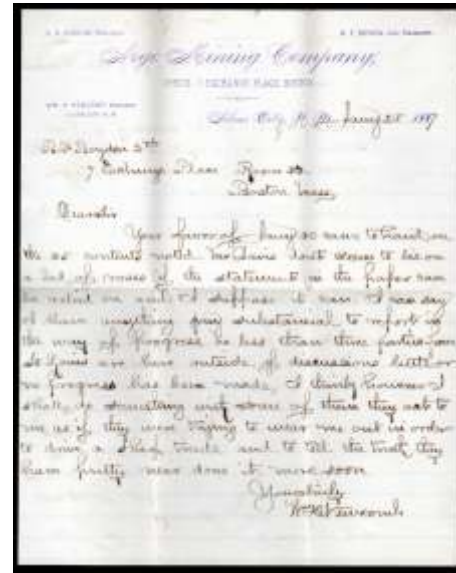
