
1851-1857 Issues



- 1 ○ **1851, 1¢ blue, type II (Scott 7)**, clear to large margins all around including part of the next stamp at left (type characteristics show clearly), light town cancel, Very Fine to Extremely Fine. Scott \$140. Estimate \$100 - 150



- 2 ○ **1852, 1¢ blue, type IV (Scott 9)**, a truly glorious stamp with immense margins (capturing portions of three surrounding stamps); meticulously printed in robust color and with an unobtrusive grid cancel, a Superb gem; with 2021 P.S.A.G. certificate graded Gem 100, *only four stamps attain this grade in PSE's Population Report*.
