Then all mint from here on, including later Queen Victoria issues complete, King Edward VII complete (definitives and Quebec issue), King George V complete including Admirals and the 1928 through 1935 definitive sets, King George VI complete including definitives and high values, plus Queen Elizabeth II complete to 1969 including definitive sets. Mostly o.g., many are never hinged although the key values tend to be hinged (\$1 Parliament is regummed). Small faults affect perhaps 10-15% of the total catalog value (mainly on early issues), the remainder is generally F.-V.F. A nice lot for the collector looking to start on Canada, or the dealer looking for better sets and singles for stock. Scott \$26,500.

One of the nicest collections of postally used Canadian stamps you can hope to find, and a great lot for the discerning collector. Scott \$12,000+.

There are also many proofs and reprints (identified as such). There is extensive coverage of Austrian regular issues 1850-1918 plus some semi-postals, airmail and postage dues, with individual catalog values up to \$200. Condition is generally F.-V.F. A superior collection of this area and excellent for the serious collector. Scott approximately \$7,000.

- 75 ★/○ **China, 1898-1990's, misc assortment of mint and used**, in 2 small stock books + stock pages, ranging from Coiling Dragons through Republic issues to PRC plus a bit of Taiwan. No rarities but many hundreds of stamps. Best is probably PRC from the 1950's. Condition is generally F.-V.F. Estimate \$250 - 350

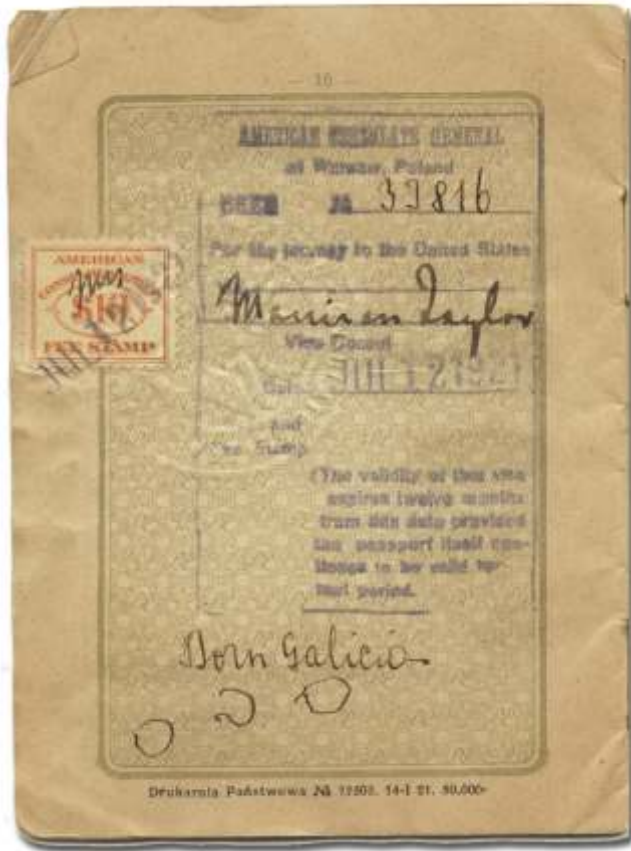

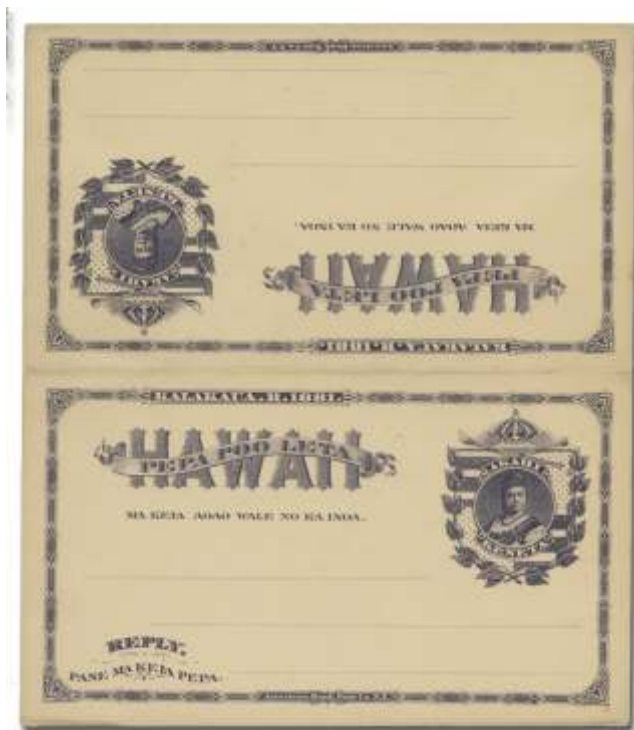

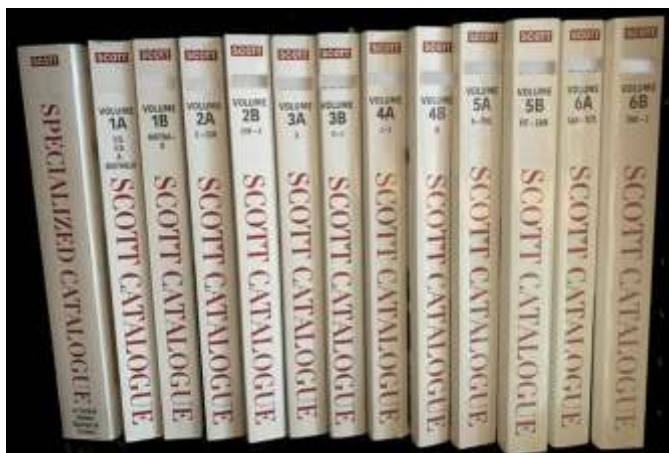
