

Early issues are more used than mint, later tend more toward mint or CTO, Full sets, part sets and some mixed mint and used sets, even a few souvenir sheets. No rarities, but plenty of items cataloging up to about \$400 each. Mostly clean with only a few faults noted in the earliest issues (which don't catalog much). Main value is probably in 20th century mint. A nice lot for a collector or for a dealer wanting to pull items from it for stock. An internet dealer could probably milk this for years. Condition averages Fine to Very Fine. A small sampling has been imaged. Shipping weight 72.5 lbs / 32.9 kilos.

Cataloged by the original owner many years ago where it came to over \$60,000 Scott. A check against recent Scott catalogs indicates the current catalog value is probably around \$70,000 to \$75,000.

★/O Worldwide, 19th and 20th century, mint and used accumulation, tens of thousands of singles on stock pages, sorted in 22 three-ring binders, each containing a specific country or area. Most countries of Europe are represented, also Latin America (including Brazil, Bolivia, Colombia, Haiti, Panama, Paraguay and Peru), plus Ghana, Israel, Japan, Mongolia and Togo. Good variety here but there is duplication with up to 10 of a kind. Overall condition is mixed with some faults but generally a clean lot, much of the mint being never hinged. A small sampling has been imaged. Shipping weight 82 lbs / 37 kilos.

52 Baker, Conrad, Harriman, Walter and Humphreys, Benjamn G. Trio of signed calling cards embossed with the state seal from 1867 by the Governors of the States of Indiana, New Hampshire and Mississippi;

Conrad Baker (February 12, 1817 - April 28, 1885) was an American attorney, military officer, and politician who served as state representative, 15th lieutenant governor, and the 15th governor of the U.S. state of Indiana from 1867 to 1873. Baker had served in the Union Army during the American Civil War, rising to the rank of colonel, but resigned following his election as lieutenant governor, during which time he played an important role in overseeing the formation and training of states levies. He served as acting-governor for five months during the illness of Governor Oliver Morton, and was elevated to Governor following Morton's resignation from office. During Baker's full term as governor, he focused primitively on the creation and improvement of institutions to help veterans and their families that had been disaffected by the war. He also championed the post-war federal constitutional amendments, and was able to successfully advocate their acceptance. This card signed while he was Lt. Governor 1867.

Walter Harriman (April 8, 1817 - July 25, 1884) was an American minister, merchant, soldier, and politician who served as the 31st governor of New Hampshire. He was a colonel in the Union Army during the American Civil War. On July 23, 1866, the United States Senate confirmed President Andrew Johnson's May 31, 1866 nomination of Harriman for appointment to the grade of brevet brigadier general of volunteers to rank from March 13, 1865.

Benjamin Grubs Humphreys (August 26, 1808 - December 20, 1882) was an American politician from Mississippi. He was a general in the Confederate States Army during the American Civil War and served as Governor of Mississippi from 1865 to 1868, during Reconstruction.
