Highlights of the Sale



- 5 ✉ 1799, folded letter from New York to Shelburne Nova Scotia, HALIFAX SHIP LRE handstamp on front with manuscript 5½ and via New York on cover to Halifax, Dec 14 99 transit stamp on reverse, Fine to Very Fine. **Hammer Price \$180**



- 55 ✉ c. 1870, cover from Massachusetts to Turkey, franked with 15¢ Bank Note (152 - catalogs \$350 on cover), the cover traveled via North German Union Mail (which only existed 1868-1871), backstamped German Postal Agency in Constantinople. The lot also contains a 1903 cover from Philadelphia to Constantinople at the regular 5¢ UPU rate, Fine to Very Fine.

- 51 ✉ 1866, cover from Vermont to England, redirected within England, with 5 British backstamps. An attractive 3-color franking and an unusual way of making the 24¢ rate, Fine to Very Fine.

- 78 ✉ [Attorney] J.D. Bennett, franked with 15L18 which on cover cats \$350 with #26, Fine to Very Fine.

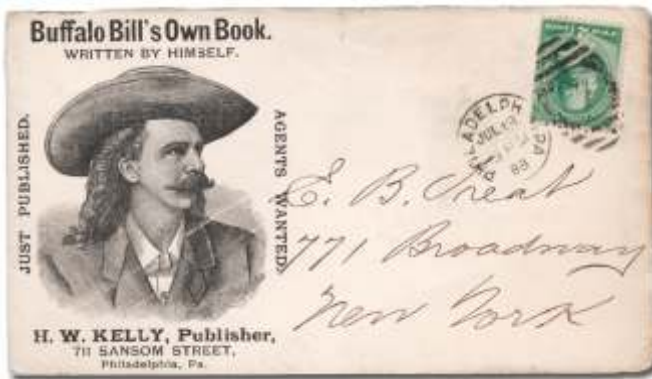
Hammer Price \$100



- 355 Circle of Hearts enclosing 6 point rosette (Waterbury, CT), beautiful strike ties a 3¢ (65) on cover to Wolcottville, CT, Very Fine, Rohloff rarity RRR - not more than 8 copies known. Rohloff J-11.

Hammer Price \$850

Similar to the illustration in Rohloff's book - this one is 3 days earlier and to a different CT town. A great Waterbury cover.



- 132 [Printing & Publishing] Buffalo Bill's Own Book, nice design of the legendary circus showman on a Bank Note era cover, Very Fine.

- 376 1930 (June 2), Europe-Pan American Round Flight, Lakehurst to Friedrichshafen, franked with US 65¢ Zeppelin (C13), used on flown May 1, 1930 post card to Germany, with all proper postmarks and cachets, Very Fine. Michel 68Gd.
